






We asked that these ballots be included in the review because our review showed that they were similar to some the county had already determined should be reviewed as wrongly rejected ballots.

4. Sherburne County, through its deputy county attorney and deputy county auditor, refused to review the wrongly rejected absentee ballots included on the Coleman campaign's list publicly (so that campaign representatives could participate) and contended that they have final veto power on what wrongly rejected absentee ballots will be reviewed by the parties for possible submission to the Secretary of State. Sherburne County has declined to include any additional ballots identified by the Coleman campaign in the group it intends to send to the Secretary of State.
