1 Pursuant to LOCAL R. CIV. P. 7.2(e), Gonzalez Plaintiffs hereby move for leave of
2 Court to file a Consolidated Response to Defendants' Motions in Limine Regarding
3 ACORN Survey Forms; Pending Criminal Investigations; Untimely Disclosures; Plaintiff
4 Expert Opinions; Late Disclosure of Witnesses; Deposition Testimony of Arturo Rosales
5 and Agnes Laughter; and Untimely Disclosures, and also move for leave to exceed the 17
6 page limitation by seven pages.¹ See Dkt. Entry Nos. 817-823. The length of the
7 Consolidated Response is appropriate given that it addresses seven of Defendants'
8 motions and is a more efficient and convenient means for the Court to review Gonzalez
9 Plaintiffs' responses. Thus, Gonzalez Plaintiffs respectfully request that this Court grant
10 leave to file a Consolidated Response and exceed the 17 page limitation to 24 pages.
