

1 registration forms prior to mailing them back to the applicant. It is believed that
2 this is why copies of Maria Gonzalez and Jesus Gonzalez's rejected voter
3 registration forms were in the possession of Yuma County officials when this
4 lawsuit was filed in May 2006.

5 9. When the lawsuit was filed, but before any discovery had been requested, Yuma
6 County provided copies of only Mr. and Mrs. Gonzalez's voter registration forms to
7 the Yuma County Attorney's Office.

8 10. No document production was requested of Yuma County by the Gonzalez Plaintiffs
9 until October 2007.

10 11. It is unknown how many other rejected voter registration forms may have been
11 copied and stored for a while, despite Yuma County's policy of returning the form
12 to the applicant.

13 12. Prior to August 2007, Yuma County had a backlog of retained documents because
14 our shredder could not handle the volume necessary to destroy documents in
15 accordance with the retention schedule. If any copies of rejected voter registration
16 forms were still being inadvertently stored in August 2007, they were likely being
17 stored with this backlog. We do not know if any rejected voter registration forms
18 were being kept at that time. However, if they were, it is likely that they would
19 have been destroyed along with a backlog of retained documents after we purchased
20 a high volume shredder in August 2007. See exhibit A, invoice for shredder.

21 13. Whether or not copies of rejected voter registration forms existed in the Yuma
22 County Recorder's Office in November 2007 is pure speculation.

14. In 2007, Yuma County began tracking rejected voter registration forms. Those

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
forms have been provided to Plaintiffs.

Further, affiant sayeth naught.



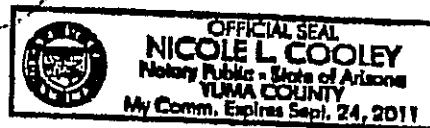
