


## DECLARATION OF DRAMETRA BROWN

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, I, Drametra Brown, hereby declare as follows:

1. I am a resident of Indianapolis, Indiana. I am a citizen of the United States and am above the age of eighteen. I have lived in the city of Indianapolis for over four years and I have lived at my current address since May 2008. I am unmarried and have no children.
2. I am not incarcerated for a felony conviction under state or federal law, I have not been found mentally incompetent for voting purposes by a court of law, and I have not been permanently disenfranchised for violations of the election laws.
3. I am a certified nurse's assistant who works at an Indianapolis nursing home. I filled out a voter registration form during a registration program for residents. I used a form given to me by a staff member of the nursing home.
4. I recently found out that my registration was rejected because it was filled out on a form that is not the same one being used now. This news was really devastating to me, as I was excited to vote for the first time. I want to make sure that I am able to cast my vote on Election Day and that my vote will count.
5. My voting rights are very important to me. There are a lot of issues that matter to me and it is very important to me that I make my voice be heard by voting on November 4, 2008.
