**SUPPLEMENTAL DECLARATION OF DONALD ROBERTS IN SUPPORT
OF THE SECRETARY'S MOTION FOR SUMMARY JUDGMENT**

Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1746, Donald Roberts submits this Supplemental Declaration in Support of the Secretary's Motion for Summary Judgment.

1. I am over the age of eighteen and competent to make this declaration. I make this declaration in support of the Secretary's Motion for Summary Judgment.

2. I am employed by the Florida Department of State as Bureau Chief of the Bureau of Departmental Applications and Systems Support. My responsibilities as Bureau Chief include overseeing the development and operation of the Florida Voter Registration System ("FVRS"),

which is Florida's "single, uniform, official, centralized, interactive, computerized statewide voter registration system as required by the Help America Vote Act of 2002," § 98.035(1), Fla. Stat. (2006), and as required by Florida law, *id.*

3. Consistent with my job responsibilities, I have access to the data contained in the FVRS, which includes a list of all registered voters, information relating to every voter registration application received after the implementation of the FVRS, and a record of whether a particular registered voter voted in any election.

4. I have reviewed Amended Schedule A, which Plaintiffs submitted in opposition to the Secretary's Motion, (doc. 293-13 at 50-55). A true and correct copy of Amended Schedule A is attached to this declaration as Attachment "A." In this declaration, I will refer to this list as the "Plaintiffs' List."

5. The Plaintiffs' List includes the names of forty-nine individuals. Comparing the names on the Plaintiffs' List to the records available in the FVRS, I learned that nineteen of the forty-nine were registered and eligible to vote in time for the 2006 election.

6. Of those nineteen, eleven actually voted. Those voting in 2006 were: Michael Bean, Jasma Cinsus, Jane Cohen, Rose Cruz, Claudette Dixon, Ernest Hitchcock, Karen Pantin, Gerladine Root, Martha Sanchez, Thomas Schendera, and Lorenzo Sharpe.

7. Eight others were eligible to vote in time for the 2006 general election but did not do so. Those were: Lilliam Avello, Jason Freeman, Bladimir Hernandez, Victoria Rodriguez, Charles Houghtaling, Juan Alberto Llossas, Amos Pierre, and Eric Toy.

8. Sixteen did not submit a drivers license number or the last four digits of their social security number. Those were: Zito Bilibio; Deval Brown, Jr., Heather Buchanan, Hubert Elie, David Fleuriot, Bryan Grimm, Sergio Hrvatin, Madeleine Jozile, Christopher Martin,

Jonathan Nilo, Edony Princivil, Jan Rokyta, Hiroshima Soto, Joan Stephenson-Coke, Nakia Sutton, and Michael Walker, Jr.

9. The address listed for Gwendolyn Sue Foote on the Plaintiffs' List is 16850 Collins Ave., Sunny Isles, Florida 33160, which is the same address listed for her in the FVRS system. That address is shared with a Mail Boxes, Etc. store. *See* <http://www.yellowpages.com/info-LMS55372362/Mail-Boxes-Etc>.

10. The following ten individuals on the Plaintiffs' List submitted applications with no omissions in required fields, but their identifying numbers did not match existing government records, and there is no record of their appearing at the supervisors' offices to confirm their identifying numbers: Patricia Anne Benvenuto, Charlenssie Carrion, Vinolia Dawkins, Juana DeJesus, Marie Olive Gayle (Kirlew), Terrell Hart, Jose Herrera, Pierre Philippe-Auguste, Maryorie Saavedra, Teresa Waters-Cain.


11. I have also reviewed the declarations of Patricia Anne Benvenuto, Bladimir Hernandez, and Marie Olive Gayle Kirlew, submitted by the Plaintiffs. I have reviewed the FVRS records associated with these three individuals. Neither Marie Olive Gayle Kirlew nor Patricia Anne Benvenuto has submitted any amendments or corrections to their applications, both of which remain pending.

12. Bladimir Hernandez was an active registered voter as of the date of the 2006 general election.

13. In my earlier declaration, I stated that Alida Rodriguez, Thomas Veal, and Stephen Haber submitted applications that were deemed incomplete because the applicant did not mark the required checkboxes. (Decl. ¶ 11.) In addition to missing checkboxes, Thomas Veal's application was submitted on an improper and outdated form, approximately one year

after he dated it (*see* Attachment "B"), and it therefore would have been rejected even with marks in the checkboxes. Moreover, there are two Stephen Habers listed at the same address, but with different birthdates (presumably a father and son). The elder Stephen Haber has been a registered voter since 1997, and the younger Stephen Haber submitted an incomplete application on August 31, 2007 and has not submitted any amendment or correction since then. The Plaintiffs' List does not indicate which Stephen Haber they reference. Finally, Alida Rodriguez has not submitted any amendment or correction to her incomplete application since submitting it on September 20, 2006.

I declare under penalty of perjury that the foregoing is true and correct. Executed at Tallahassee, Florida, on November 5, 2007.


4. I am not now, ~~and have never been~~, a member of any union.


