MEMORANDUM OF INTERVENOR CONGRESSMAN HENRY CUELLAR  
IN SUPPORT OF  
AMENDED BIPARTISAN COMPROMISE PLAN

Now comes Congressman Henry Cuellar to advise this Court of his continuing support for the Bipartisan Compromise Plan as corrected (i.e. Plan 1425C).

Congressmen Henry Bonilla and Lamar Smith have filed with this Court an amended Bipartisan Compromise Plan that, as explained in their memorandum of July 26, 2006, merely corrects a handful of very minor errors in the original Bipartisan Compromise Plan ( Plan 1422C) filed on July 14<sup>th</sup>. As indicated in the congressmen's brief, the corrected plan was available on the Texas Legislative Council's RedAppl and RedViewer shortly after the initial plan was filed. Several filings with this Court on July 23 made note of the presence of this slightly amended plan.

Congressman Henry Cuellar advises this Court that he continues to support the Bipartisan Compromise Plan as corrected in Plan 1425C.


