25 On September 25, 2006 the Inter Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc., *et al.*
26 (the "ITCA Plaintiffs") filed a Motion for Injunction Pending Appeal, for which the
27 ITCA Plaintiffs requested expedited consideration. On September 29, 2006, the ITCA
28 Plaintiffs filed an Emergency and Urgent Motion for Injunction Pending Appeal with

1 the Ninth Circuit Court of Appeals. On October 5, 2006, the Ninth Circuit granted the
2 ITCA Plaintiffs' Motion, and today denied defendants' Motions for Reconsideration.
3 As such, "Proposition 200's voting identification requirement" has been enjoined "in
4 connection with Arizona's November 7, 2006 general election" and "Proposition 200's
5 registration proof of citizenship requirements" was enjoined "so that voters [could]
6 register before the October 9, 2006 registration deadline." [*Gonzalez v. Arizona*, No.
7 06-16702, 06-16706, Order at 1-2 (9th Cir., Oct. 5, 2006)] Accordingly, the ITCA
8 Plaintiffs hereby withdraw the Motion for Injunction Pending Appeal filed with this
9 Court.
