This letter is submitted pursuant to a request by the Honorable Stephen J. Murphy, III, the presiding District Court Judge in this civil action.

The parties in this case have agreed to participate in a settlement conference currently scheduled for May 25, 2010, and presided over by the Honorable Bernard Friedman of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Michigan.
