**ORDER GRANTING DEFENDANTS'
MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE EXCESS PAGES**

Defendants in this case have moved for leave to file a brief in opposition to plaintiffs' motion for a preliminary injunction in excess of the 20-page limit established by Local Rule 7.1(c)(3). The Court is cognizant that this recently-filed case involves challenges to two separate practices of Michigan election officials with respect to the maintenance of the state's voter rolls, and has the potential to significantly hamper the defendants' administration of Michigan's voter registration system. Further, on September 23rd the Court granted a similar motion by the plaintiffs to file a brief in excess of 20 pages in support of the instant motion. Docket no. 7.

ACCORDINGLY, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that defendants' September 26th motion for leave to file excess pages [docket entry 16] is GRANTED.
