4 Recorder, and Lynn Constabile, Yavapai County Election Director, hereby respectfully respond
5 to First Set of Interrogatories from Plaintiffs Inter Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc., et al. served on
6 July 5, 2006 as follows:

9 was alleged to have registered to vote in your county; (b) a non-United States citizen
10 was alleged to have voted at a polling place in your county; (c) a non-United States
11 citizen was alleged to have voted in your county by early ballot pursuant to A.R.S. §
12 16-542(A); and (d) an individual impersonated a registered voter at a polling place in
13 your county. With respect to each incident, please provide: (i) the name, last known
14 address and telephone number of the individual and whether the individual was
15 lawfully in the United States at the time of the incident; (ii) the date the individual was
16 registered to vote and/or voted; and (iii) whether criminal charges were filed against
17 the individual and, if so, the case caption, court, docket number and disposition.

Answer

- 23,270 voter registration forms have been submitted since December 8, 2004.
- i) 12,986 new registration forms were accepted along with 10,281 changes of address for a total of 23,268 accepted forms.
 - ii) 484 forms were rejected for failing to provide satisfactory proof of citizenship.
 - iii) Two forms were rejected for other reasons

4. State the total number of voters who were registered in your county on the effective date of the amendment to A.R.S. § 16-166 and who, pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-166(G), were deemed to have provided satisfactory evidence of citizenship and not required to resubmit evidence of citizenship unless changing voter registration from one county to another.

Answer

There were 99,842 total active registered voters as of November 2, 2004. There were 10,714 inactive registered voters as of October 15, 2004.

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5. For each election conducted in your county since the implementation of the voting-related provisions of the Arizona Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act, please state the number of registered voters who (a) voted by mail; (b) cast a regular ballot at a polling place; (c) were not permitted to cast a regular ballot at a polling place due to the failure to provide identification required by A.R.S. § 16-579; (d) cast a provisional ballot due to the failure to provide identification required by A.R.S. § 16-579; (e) cast a provisional ballot and subsequently provided satisfactory proof of identification to the county recorder's office; and (f) cast a provisional ballot that was not counted due to failure to provide identification required by A.R.S. § 16-579. In addition, please identify any analyses, reports or studies in your possession that address the above.

8 **Answer**

9 Total Mail in Ballot voters during this period were 69,004. A total number of 1,891
10 voters, voted at the polls. During the relevant time frame all polling place elections
11 occurred prior to implementation of the Secretary of State's Prop 200 identification
12 procedures so no voter were affected by identification issues relating to A.R.S. sec 16-
13 579.

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6. Identify the forms of identification that have been deemed acceptable by your county to establish the identity of electors in accordance with the requirements of A.R.S. § 16-579(A).

- 22 • Valid Arizona driver license
23 • Valid Arizona nonoperating identification license
24 • Tribal enrollment card or other form of tribal identification
25 • Valid United States federal, state, or local government issued identification

26 An identification is "valid" unless it can be determined on its face that it has expired.

Acceptable forms of identification without a photograph that bear the name and address of the elector (two required)

- Utility bill of the elector that is dated within ninety days of the date of the election. A utility bill may be for electric, gas, water, solid waste, sewer, telephone, cellular phone, or cable television
• Bank or credit union statement that is dated within ninety days of the date of the election
• Valid Arizona Vehicle Registration
• Indian census card
• Property tax statement of the elector's residence
• Tribal enrollment card or other form of tribal identification
• Vehicle insurance card
• Recorder's Certificate

1 • Valid United States federal, state, or local government issued identification, including a voter
2 registration card issued by the county recorder

3 * Any "Official Election Material" mailing bearing a voter's name and address.

4 7. Provide a breakdown of the number of voter registration applications submitted in
5 your county since the date of implementation of the amendment to A.R.S. § 16-152
6 (requiring that voter registration forms contain proof of United States citizenship), that
7 were (a) Arizona Voter Registration Forms, (b) Federal Mail Voter Registration

10 23,270 voter registration applications have been submitted since December 8, 2004 of which
11 10,281 were requests for change of address. Of the 23,270 submitted voter registration
12 applications submitted, 23,072 forms were Arizona forms and 198 were Federal Mail Voter
13 Registration Forms.

Neither the Greenlee County Recorder nor Elections Director have generated any reports, conducted any studies, or issued any memorandum that either discuss or relate to the voting-related provisions of the ATCPA other than: (1) brief comments prepared by the Elections Director regarding proposed changes to the Sec. of State's Elections Procedure Manual; and, (2) procedures which relate to identification at the polls which have been prepared for Department of Justice pre-clearance. Both of these items have been included with the documents requested by plaintiffs in their Request to Produce #3.

3. Provide the total number of voter registration forms in your county that have been submitted since the date of implementation of the amendment to A.R.S. 16-152 set forth in the ATCPA (requiring that voter registration forms contain proof of United States citizenship), and of that total number provide the number that were (i) accepted (i.e., the applicant was registered), (ii) rejected due to the application form's failure to contain satisfactory proof of citizenship as required by Proposition 200, and (iii) rejected for reasons other than the application form's failure to contain proof of citizenship. There have been 300 total voter registration forms submitted to Greenlee County as of July 18, 2006. Of that number 283 have been accepted; 12 have been rejected due to failure to provide satisfactory proof of citizenship; 5 have been rejected for reasons other than failure to provide satisfactory proof of citizenship.

4. State the total number of voters who were registered in your county on the effective date of the amendment to A.R.S. § 16-166 and who, pursuant to A.R.S. § 16-166(G), were deemed to have provided satisfactory evidence of citizenship and not required to resubmit evidence of citizenship unless changing voter registration from one county to another.

The Greenlee County has been unable to access archived records to obtain an exact number of voters that were registered as of the effective date of A.R.S. § 16-166, 12/8/04, however, as of 12/1/04, there were 4507 total registered voters in Greenlee County.

As of 1/24/05, the date Prop. 200 was pre-cleared by the Department of Justice there were 4511 total registered voters in Greenlee County.

No registered voters were required to resubmit evidence of citizenship.

5. For each election conducted in your county since the implementation of the voting-related provisions of the Arizona Taxpayer and Citizen Protection Act, please state the number of registered voters who (a) voted by mail; (b) cast a regular ballot at a polling place; (c) were not permitted to cast a regular ballot at a polling place due to the failure to provide identification required by A.R.S. § 16-579; (d) cast a provisional ballot due to the failure to provide identification required by A.R.S. § 16-579; (e) cast a provisional ballot and subsequently provided satisfactory proof of identification to the county recorder's office; and (f) cast a provisional ballot that was not counted due to failure to provide identification required by A.R.S. § 16-579. The only election held in Greenlee County since the implementation of the ATCPA was a city council election held in Clifton, Arizona. As to that election:

A) 73 people voted by mail in ballot.

B) 79 people voted a regular ballot at a polling place.

C) 1 person was not permitted to cast a regular ballot at a polling place due to failure to provide satisfactory identification.

D) 1 person cast a provisional ballot at the polling place for failure to provide satisfactory identification.

E) 0 persons cast a provisional ballot at the polling place and subsequently provided satisfactory identification.

F) 1 person cast a provisional ballot at the polling place that was not counted due to failure to provide satisfactory identification.
