Re: Lopez Torres et al. v. New York State Board of Elections (CV04-1129 (JG))

Dear Judge Gleeson:

We write on behalf of plaintiffs to provide, as per the Court's Order of January 20, new versions of several maps submitted as exhibits at the preliminary injunction hearing. We enclose with this filing the following new maps as Plaintiffs' Exhibits 127-131:

- (1) Pl. Ex. 127: A revised map of the entire state with judicial district, assembly district, and county lines for all areas outside New York City and Long Island (formerly, Pl. Ex. 1). Although the map is in color, we have attempted to darken the assembly district lines and alter the shading of the judicial districts to make the divisions clearer when the document is copied in black and white.
- (2) Pl. Ex. 128: A separate map of the First Judicial District with county and assembly district lines;
- (3) Pl. Ex. 129: A separate map of the Second Judicial District with county and assembly district lines;
- (4) Pl. Ex. 130: A separate map of the Eleventh Judicial District with county and assembly district lines;
- (5) Pl. Ex. 131: A separate map of the Twelfth Judicial District with county and assembly district lines.

We also wish to bring to the Court's attention that Plaintiff Steven Banks seeks to withdraw as a plaintiff. Since this lawsuit was filed, Mr. Banks has become the Attorney-In-Chief in charge of the legal practice of the Legal Aid Society, which is largely publicly funded, and feels that he should not be an individual plaintiff in this matter. Although this request has no bearing on the preliminary injunction motion presently before the Court, we believed that the Court and all parties should be apprised at this time. We will file the appropriate stipulation or motion shortly after consultation with counsel for defendants.
