1 COME NOW, Applicants for Intervention, Yes on Proposition 200 and Randall
2 Pullen ("Applicants"), by and through their undersigned attorney, hereby move, pursuant
3 to Fed. R. Civ. P. 24, to intervene in this case for the purpose of defending Proposition
4 200. As set for in the accompanying Memorandum in Support of Motion to Intervene and
5 the Declarations attached thereto, Applicants seek intervention as of right or, in the
6 alternative, permissive intervention under Fed. R. Civ. P. 24(a) and Fed. R. Civ. P. 24 (b),
7 respectively.

10 Counsel for the parties were consulted regarding this Motion to Intervene.
11 Telephone messages for Counsel for Plaintiffs Maria M. Gonzalez and others were left
12 with Daniel Ortega on the morning of June 16, 2006, and with Neil Bradley and Nina
13 Perales on the afternoon of June 16, 2006. None of the above attorneys had responded by
14 noon, June 19, 2006.

16 On the afternoon of June 16, 2006, a telephone message was left with Benjamin
17 Blustein, Counsel for Plaintiffs The Inter Tribal Council of Arizona, Inc., and others.
18 That same afternoon David Bodney was contacted and stated that at that time his clients
19 took no position on the Motion to Intervene.
20

21 Telephone messages for Counsel for Defendants Jan Brewer and the State of
22 Arizona were left with both Mary Ruth O'Grady and Peter Silverman on the afternoon of
23 June 16, 2006. Later that evening, Mr. Silverman left a voicemail for Mr. Spector that did
24 not indicate Defendants' position on the Motion to Intervene.

26 On June 19, 2006, M. Colleen Connor, Counsel for Defendants County Recorders
27 and Election Directors, stated that she had "no objection" to the Motion to Intervene.


